A motion was made by Kandler, seconded by Schreiner, and carried to approve the agenda.

A motion was made by Schreiner, seconded by Jacobson, and carried to approve the minutes from the previous meeting.

A motion was made by Jacobson, seconded by Wempner and carried to adjourn the open session and reconvene in closed session to consider performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the Commission has jurisdiction, per Wisconsin State Statute 19.85 (1)(b)&(c) including the consideration of performance, evaluation data and pending charges against Officer Steven Presto.

A motion was made by Schreiner, seconded by Kandler and carried to adjourn the closed session and reconvene in open session.

Chief Reedy advised that our police department will be hiring two part time officers and one full time officer. There will be a joint hiring process with the Kiel Police Department. There is an April 30th deadline for applications for the part time positions, the full time position will be filled from within. The department currently has 7 part time officers and 6 full time officers, including Chief Reedy and Capt. Hebl.

The next meeting date will be May 6th, 2013 at 3pm at New Holstein City Hall.

A motion to adjourn was made by Wempner, seconded by Schreiner and carried.

Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:16 am.
