



CITY OF NEW HOLSTEIN HEAVY REFUSE PICK-UP DAY

Monday, APRIL 22, 2013---Beginning at 5:00AM

New this year, the City of New Holstein will be offering a heavy refuse pick-up on Monday, April 22, 2013. This event is for City of New Holstein Residents ONLY.

ACCEPTABLE LANDFILL ITEMS

- ▶ Couches, chairs, tables, desks, sinks, toilets, bedsprings, mattresses, bed frames or any other household furniture. Stoves, washers, dryers, lamps, or any household appliances
- ▶ Bicycles and bicycle parts
- ▶ **Smaller** amounts of Carpeting, pads from carpeting, and rugs---cut into 4 foot sections and tied securely.
- ▶ Swing sets, clothesline poles---concrete must be removed from poles
- ▶ **Non-hazardous** household refuse that is properly bagged or bundled---no loose material
- ▶ LATEX paint can be disposed of ONLY if the covers are removed and the paint remaining in the can has been allowed to harden.

NOT ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- ▶ Tires and car batteries--Contact local auto/tire dealer or retailer
- ▶ Appliances Containing Freon (Refrigerators, de-humidifiers, air conditioners, freezers, etc.) contact a professional waste hauler or appliance dealer
- ▶ **Large** amounts of construction & remodeling debris, such as carpeting and carpet pads, plaster, shingles, and siding require a dumpster at your own expense.
- ▶ Yard Waste--shrubs, branches, grass clippings, leaves, etc.---drop off at the City's compost site located on Taft Avenue
- ▶ Used Engine Oil only---site located within the City's compost site on Taft Avenue.
- ▶ Left over Medication (including pet) ---dispose of at New Holstein Police Department's Permanent Drop Box.
- ▶ Rechargeable batteries and alkaline batteries (like AA, AAA, D, C, etc.)---Contact a battery retailer

Items listed below Save for Hazardous Wastes/Computers & Electronic Disposal ** MAY 11, 2013**
At the New Holstein Public Works Garage, 1319 Taft Avenue, for Calumet County Residents ONLY

- ▶ Fluorescent bulb tubes---(no CFLs---the curly ones) Button Batteries
- ▶ Yard chemicals, Cleaners, Acids and Bases, Vehicle products, thermometers and thermostats
- ▶ Oil based paint and Liquids such as leftover spray cans, chemicals, varnishes, solvents, etc.
- ▶ Electronic items such as computer monitors, telephones, laptops, CPU's, fax machines, printers, photocopiers, VCRs, DVD players, Blue Ray players, televisions, radios, phones, and cell phones
